- Proficient in operation of POS system and supporting equipment
- Efficiently scan tickets and membership cards to ensure an accurate guest count
- Knowledge of Zoo experiences and membership benefits
- Fully trained in current sales strategies and tools (i.e., visual aids)
- Provide service in a timely and professional manner
- Actively utilize current sales strategies in each applicable interaction. (i.e., follow script)
- Inform guests/members of daily "need-to-know/nice-to-know" information
- Share your Zoo "insider" information
- Knowledge and ability to answer guest/member questions
- Hand out and put away mobility rentals
- Availability to cover special event shifts and extra shifts during peak times
- Work as an integral part of the Zoo team and communicate effectively with coworkers and management
- Participate in team goals and objectives
