This person's role will be to ensure that the zoo vehicles and mechanical equipment are working as intended and safely. ## EDUCATION AND RELEVANT EXPERIENCE REQUIREMENTS

### **REQUIRED:**

- Ability to diagnose, and repair gas powered vehicles, and battery powered train engines.
- General computer skills including emails, work order system, word, and excel.
- Driver's License.

## PERFORMANCE RESPONSIBILITIES

### ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS:

- Gas powered vehicle types include trucks, vans, cars, train engines, lawn equipment, golf carts, dredgers, pumps, pressure washers, train cars and generators.
- Battery powered vehicles include electric train engines.
- Completion of repairs to vehicles and equipment promptly.
- Schedule and communicate repairs with departments as needed.
- Attend all meetings as asked, whether daily, monthly, or annually.
- Enter all vehicle information and descriptions of repairs in the work order/ PM system.



- Keep track of work time in the payroll system.
- Follow all OSHA and zoo safety procedures that apply.
- Order and maintain stocked parts for our inventory.
- Maintain professional behavior, productivity, reliability, and attention to detail.
- Keep departments updated as repairs continue, especially if there are any delays.
- Drive to stores, dealerships and warehouses for parts when needed.
- Repairs to gas powered vehicles will include engine malfunctions, preventative maintenance, brakes, safety equipment, wheels tires, batteries, fueling, cooling systems, greasing, blades, controls, motors, fueling, hoses, electronics, A/C, fluids, etc.
- Repairs to electric train engines will include wiring, batteries, greasing, contactors, controls, brakes, charging pad and station, motors, fluids, pneumatics, and hoses. Assistance from the manufacturer of the train engine may be necessary at times.
- Heavy duty equipment repairs on backhoe, lull and skid steer would involve hoses, fluids, bearings, brakes, body work, and wiring.
- Swap out train engines to get the backup engine some run time or for service on primary engine.
- Occasional availability on off hours, weekends and being on call for emergencies will be necessary.

## KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS AND ABILITIES:

- High mechanical knowledge and experience is important.
- A great attention to detail.
- Any certificates would be a plus.
