ZOO TEEN PROGRAM INVOLVMENT CONTRACT

APPLICANT NAME _____

The Zoo Teen Program at Brevard Zoo is an extensive twelve (12) month commitment that runs from February to February of the following year. Upon acceptance, Teens are expected to pay dues of \$50.00. This covers the costs of a teen manual, uniform polo, name tag, mandatory background check (requires a signed approval form), and various supplies (financial assistance is available). Once selected, the Zoo Teen undergoes five (5) weeks of training beginning in early January 2027. Presence at training is required. Following training, the trainee must pass an exam with an 80% or higher. Failure to do so will require re-takes (up to 2) until minimum score is met. The Teen is assigned one designated Saturday or Sunday a month as their volunteer day. The volunteer day currently runs from 9:00a.m. to 3:15p.m. Teens may sign-up for additional days as they choose throughout the year. In June and July, Teens may sign up for open shifts throughout the week as their schedules allow for a minimum of 30 summer hours.

Teen volunteers are allowed three (3) "unexcused" absences of their assigned volunteer days annually. On the fourth unexcused miss, the Teen may be dismissed from the program. The program does not provide make-up days or switching volunteer days with another Teen. The program accepts the following as an "excused" absence, with other allowances granted on an individual basis:

- ◆ Court Appointments or Court Ordered Visitation
- ◆ Family Emergency with a Signed Parental Note
- ◆ Absence due to illness (is excused, but requires makeup to be scheduled with the Teen Lead Staff)

Having read and understood this, please complete the following:

Initial ____ I understand that the Zoo Teen Program is a 12-month commitment. I understand that I am allowed three (3) absences from my Volunteer Days. I understand that on the fourth (4) miss, I may be dismissed from the program. I acknowledge that sporting events and other activities – except those noted above – are considered unexcused absences.

Initial ____ I understand that I must adhere to all Zoo policies and regulations, including behavioral expectations. I understand that any form of bullying is not tolerated and may result in dismissal from the program.

Initial ____ I understand that approval and passing of a background check is required for program participation.

Initial ____ I understand that once selected, I will undergo 5 weeks of training. I understand that I must make every attempt to be present for all training days at the times specified. No-showing on training days may result in dismissal.

Initial ____ I understand that upon completion of training, I will take a test and will need to achieve an 80% or higher. Failure to do so will require re-takes (up to 2) until I achieve this score.

Initial ____ I understand that once selected, I will be assigned one designated Saturday or Sunday a month OR a Friday assigned day for homeschoolers. On this day, I am expected to volunteer the hours required. I understand that in lieu of regular weekend days in June/July, there is a summer volunteer requirement of 30 volunteer hours.
