You are about to embark on a five-day adventure with Brevard Zoo.

Please arrive by 8am each morning, so we can leave on time for our trips!

The week's agenda is as follows:

- **Monday** – Explorers stay onsite at the Zoo get conservation project introductions, wetland kayaking, learn how to operate ROVs, and behind the scene tours.
- **Tuesday** – Explorers will travel to a local park for scrub jay monitoring, visit the Viera Wetlands for observations, and have a Frogwatch introduction.
- **Wednesday** – Explorers will travel to a local park on the Indian River Lagoon to go seining and practice ROV piloting. **Please bring/wear swim suit, dry clothes, water shoes, and towel.**
- **Thursday** – Explorers will stay onsite at the Zoo to participate in these conservation projects: Beach mice, mangroves, oysters, and diamondback terrapins.
