WHO ARE THE CAMP COUNSELORS?

Counselors are Zoo education staff and/or certified Brevard County teachers. Experienced docents and trained volunteers from the Zoo's teen volunteer program assist with camps.

HOW MANY KIDS ARE IN EACH CAMP?

There are approximately 12 kids in kindergarten, 24 kids in each 1st to 6th grade camp and 12 in Earth Explorers camp.

WILL MY CHILD NEED TO BRING A SNACK AND LUNCH?

Campers will need to bring snacks & refillable water bottle each day. Campers attending 1st to 6th grade full-day camps will need to bring their own lunch except on Friday (pizza will be provided.) Earth Explorers need to bring their own lunch except on Monday (pizza will be provided.)

WILL CAMP BE CANCELED DUE TO INCLEMENT WEATHER?

No. Activities will be modified to keep campers inside. Drop off and pick up procedures will also be modified.

WHAT SHOULD MY CHILD WEAR?

Children should dress according to that day's weather, such as shorts and a t-shirt. Please ensure that your child wears closed toed shoes, sunscreen, and insect repellent.

WHAT IF MY CHILD NEEDS TO BE DROPPED OFF LATE, PICKED UP EARLY OR I CANNOT MAKE IT TO 4 PM PICKUP?

Please come to the Education Office to drop off your child after the camp begins or to pick them up early. Campers not picked up by 4:15 PM will be taken to the Education Office.
