ZOO TEEN PROGRAM INVOLVEMENT CONTRACT

APPLICANT'S NAME _____

The Zoo Teen Program at Brevard Zoo is an extensive twelve (12) month commitment that runs from February to February. Once selected into the program, the Teen undergoes six (6) weeks of training beginning in early January 2019. A tentative training schedule is included on the information page. Presence at training is required. Following training, the Teen will need to pass an exam with an 80% or higher. Failure to do so will require re-takes (up to 2) until minimum score is met. Once the exam is passed, the Teen is placed on a team and assigned one designated Saturday or Sunday a month as their volunteer day. The volunteer day currently runs from 9:00 a.m. to 3:00p.m. In June and July, Teens choose weekday volunteer times and are not required to volunteer on their weekends. Teens may sign-up for additional days as they choose. Upon acceptance, Teens must pay dues of \$35.00. This covers the costs of a teen manual, teen shirt, nametag, and various supplies (financial assistance is available).

Teen participants are allowed to miss three of their assigned volunteer days. On the fourth unexcused miss, the Teen may be dismissed from the program. The program does not provide make-up days. The program does not allow switching volunteer days with another Teen. The program will accept the following as an "excused" absence:

- ◆ Court Appointments
- ◆ Court Ordered Visitation
- ◆ Family Deaths with a Signed Parental Note
- ◆ Other "excused" absences may be granted on an individual basis, with at least two-week notice.

Having read and understood this, please complete the following:

Initial ____ I understand that the Zoo Teen Program is a 12 month commitment. I understand that I am allowed three (3) absences from my Volunteer Days. I understand that on the fourth (4) miss, I will be dismissed from the program. I acknowledge that sporting events, illness, and other activities – except those noted above – are considered unexcused absences.

Initial ____ I understand that once selected, I will undergo 6 weeks of training. I understand that I must make every attempt to be present for all training days at the times specified.

Initial ____ I understand that upon completion of training, I will take a test and will need to achieve an 80% or higher. Failure to do so will require re-takes (up to 2) until I achieve this score.

Initial ____ I understand that once selected, I will be assigned one designated Saturday or Sunday a month. On this day, I am expected to volunteer the hours required. I understand that there will be an additional summer volunteer requirement (normally 25 hours).
